Stepladder Plus (the incentivised programme)

In order to take the Stepladder Plus you must:

- Have an active Junior ISA or Child Trust Fund (CTF) under the Government scheme: this means you can't be 18 or over.
- 2. Have reached your 15th birthday.
- 3. Be 'looked after' by a local authority which is participating in the scheme.

You can check whether your local authority is included by going to the registration page https://stepladderplus.sharefound.org and seeing whether it's included in the drop-down list.

If you're able to take Stepladder Plus, here's the money you can earn which is paid into your Junior ISA or Child Trust Fund account as you take each step:

- 1. Literacy £150
- 2. Numeracy £150
- 3. Financial capability (1) £200
- 4. Plan for the future £250
- 5. Financial capability (2) £350
- 6. Mentoring £400

So you can earn an additional £1,500 in your account by taking the six steps.

You will need a computer, laptop, tablet or smartphone, with internet connection and a personal email address for access.








YOUR MONEY



- 2. **Numeracy** that is, handling numbers up to functional skill Level 2
- 3. **Financial capability** (1) Making my Money Work basic money sense
- 4. **Plan for the future** 250 words on your plans for the future
- Financial capability (2) Managing my Money an
 8 week radio course with lots of money info
- Mentoring securing future education, employment, training, or sustaining one or more of them with individual help
